

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The Pike County Board of Commissioners will receive sealed Bids at Pike County Government Building, located at 230 Waverly Plaza, Suite 1000, Waverly, Ohio 45690:

**Monday, February 25th, 2019, 10:00 am**

Opened and read aloud immediately thereafter for the necessary services for the "**Red Hollow Road Box Culvert Replacement Project, PIK-CR76-3.83 (Part A) & Paving A Portion of Red Hollow Road, CR76 (From Anderson Road, TR642 to Mile Marker 4.15 = .51 Miles of Paving, Part B)**".

All Bids shall be made in conformity with the plans and specifications and shall be on the forms bound in the specifications and prepared as outlined in the Information for Bidders, General Conditions, and Supplementary General Conditions, and special funding agency requirements. The Bidder is to utilize the forms contained within the contract documents and submit that document along with any necessary attachments as described in these specifications at the designated time and place of the bid opening.

Plans and specifications may be obtained from the Pike County Office of Community & Economic Development, 116 S. Market Street, Suite 103, Waverly, Ohio 45690 for a complimentary set. The Contract Documents may be examined at the following location: Pike County Office of Community & Economic Development, between the hours of 8:30 am. to 4:00 pm. Monday – Friday.

Each Bid shall be accompanied by a BID GUARANTY AND CONTRACT BOND as required by Section 153.54 and 153.571 of the Ohio Revised Code in an amount equal to the sum of the proposal, supported by a Power of Attorney for the bonding agent, a Certificate from the Department of Insurance authorizing the Surety Company to do Surety business in the State of Ohio, and a current financial statement of the Surety Company. The bond shall be on the form bound in the specifications, which bond shall be forthwith returned to the bidder in case the contract is awarded to another bidder. In lieu of posting the Bond, a Contractor may use a Cashier's Check, Certified Check or Letter of Credit for 10% of the Bid as Bid Security. When a check or Letter of Credit is used, the Contractor will be required to post a 100% Performance Bond and a 100% Labor and Material Payment Bond, upon signing of the contract.

Each Bid must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each Bidder must submit a complete listing of all subcontractors to be used. The owner intends and requires that this project be completed no later than **August 1, 2019**.

Bids are to be sealed and addressed to the Attention of: Pike County Board of Commissioners, 230 Waverly Plaza, Suite 1000, Waverly, Ohio 45690. If forwarded by mail, the sealed envelope containing the Bid must be enclosed in another envelope addressed as above. Bidders shall state on the outside of the Bid envelope, "**Red Hollow Road Box Culvert Replacement Project, Parts A&B**".

All Contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable use Ohio Products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of this project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

Contractors and Subcontractors for this project shall at all times comply with all requirements of the Ohio Civil Rights Act, and shall, if requested by governing bodies, supply all reports or other information requested by them. The Pike County Board of Commissioners reserves the right to waive any informality or to reject any or all bids. No bidder may withdraw his Bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the date set for the opening thereof.

**NOTE:** Only bids submitted by "Contractors prequalified with the Ohio Department of Transportation, Bureau of Contractor Qualifications" will be accepted on this project. In order for a contractor to be awarded a construction contract on this project, a current "Certificate of Qualification" must be submitted prior to award of the contract showing qualification to perform the type of work included in this construction contract. It is acceptable to utilize an ODOT prequalified subcontractor to perform the paving portion of the project, (Part B). A current "Certificate of Qualification" must be submitted by any proposed paving subcontractor prior to contract award. The amount of the Certificate of Qualifications must exceed the amount of the bid on this project. Any bid submitted by a contractor who is not prequalified as required herein will be rejected.

The Board of Pike County Commissioners reserve the right to waive irregularities and to reject any or all bids for the best interest of Pike County.
