Pike County Solid Waste Management District (PCSWMD) will be awarding 5 graduating high school seniors a \$1,250.00 scholarship each, for the 2023 – 2024 school year. The purpose of this scholarship is to aid students pursuing a degree in the environmental field with expenses while attending college, as well as encourage them to broaden their knowledge base of solid waste management in our area. To ensure that your application is reviewed and processed as quickly and accurately as possible, please read and follow these procedures and requirements as written:

Procedures:

All applicants must:

- Personally complete the application and essay paper.
- Enclose only the items required.
- Submit all required documents together.
- Send completed application and documents to Pike Solid Waste Management District, Attn: Daphne Mosley, 116 S. Market Street, Suite 103, Waverly OH 45690. Faxes or emails will <u>not</u> be accepted.
- **Deadline**: Only those applications postmarked on or before March 29, 2024, will be considered.
- Applications and research papers become the property of Pike County Solid Waste Management District and will **not** be returned to the applicant.
- Please understand that submitting this application is in no way guarantee that a scholarship will be granted.
- The Pike County Solid Waste Management District Selection Committee reserves the right to reject any and all submissions.

Eligibility Requirements

- A graduating high school senior, attending a school in Pike County.
- Pursuing a degree in an environmental field.
- A Pike County resident
- Enrolled as a student at a higher education institution at time of issuance.

- Application
- Essay (see application for details)
- High school transcript copy
- Two signed letters of recommendation from a mentor, teacher, civic leader, or organization/club leader who knows the applicant personally. (Endorsements from parents will not be accepted)
